The New Mexico State University Alternative Licensure Program is a competitive post-baccalaureate, graduate level New Mexico Public Education Department (NMPED) approved teacher licensure pathway designed to prepare qualified classroom teachers. The alternative licensure program features face-to-face and online courses as well as university supervisors to facilitate on-going field coaching and mentoring. Each teacher candidate accepted to the alternative licensure program will meet licensure requirements within the two-year time limit set by the NMPED. NMSU is committed to building a professional learning community that is responsive to the context of an alternative licensure candidate and the diverse New Mexico communities they serve. We seek to guide practice, reflection, and ability to grow and remain in the profession.

## **ELIGIBILITY & SELECTION**

The NMSU Alternative Licensure Program aims to recruit highly qualified individuals who have earned a bachelor's degree or higher in a related field and are eligible (see below for eligibility requirements) for a New Mexico alternative license pathway. We seek individuals who will have a positive impact on the social, cultural, emotional, and intellectual growth of children with whom they will work throughout their career.

#### **Conditional Acceptance (Eligibility)**

A candidate is \*conditionally accepted when an evaluation of transcripts has been performed by the Clinical Director of Alternative Licensure to determine that the candidate:

Meets **minimum** state requirements of a bachelor's (or master's or doctoral) degree and course requirements of 30 undergraduate credit hours (6.60.3.9 NMAC) in the teaching field (or 12 graduate level courses) with a minimum 2.75 GPA (3.0 for NMSU Graduate School). \*If a district hires a student but the student does not qualify for the alternative license program it is the responsibility of the student to notify the district of non-acceptance to the program.

A candidate is fully accepted to the program only when: an evaluation of transcripts has been performed; NMSU has received all the required documentation; AND a copy of intent to hire or teaching contract is received from the district.

In the event of acceptance, the ALC must take steps to become a student at New Mexico State University through application to the Graduate School and the School of Teacher Preparation, Administration, and Leadership. (<a href="http://gradadmissions.nmsu.edu/">http://gradadmissions.nmsu.edu/</a>)
