Students who complete HIST 2110 (New Mexico History) from any NMSU system-wide campus or any other New Mexico college/university will be required to take an additional 3 credit 300+ level HIST course to meet the state licensure requirement of 12 upper division (300+ level) credits in Social Studies and the General Education Alternative for the second Viewing the Wider World requirement of NMSU.

Developmental Math and Developmental English courses are included on transcripts and will be calculated in the grade point average, but do not count towards total degree credit hours.
