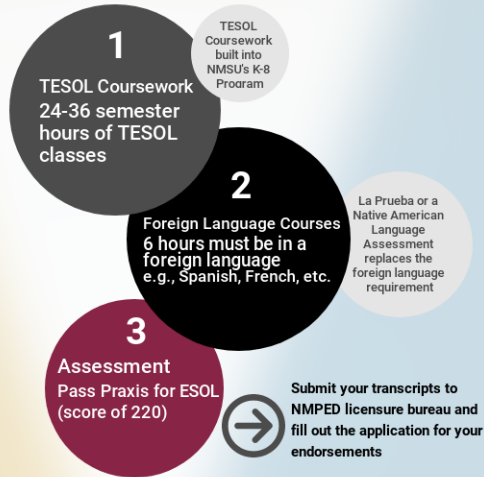

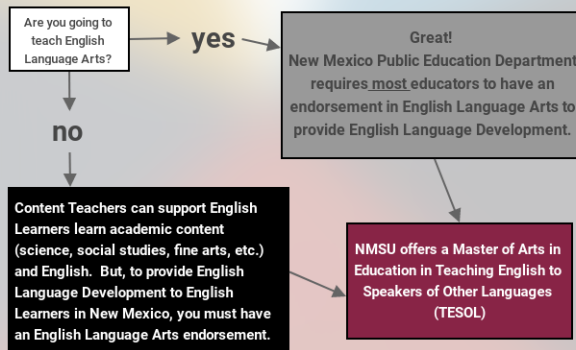

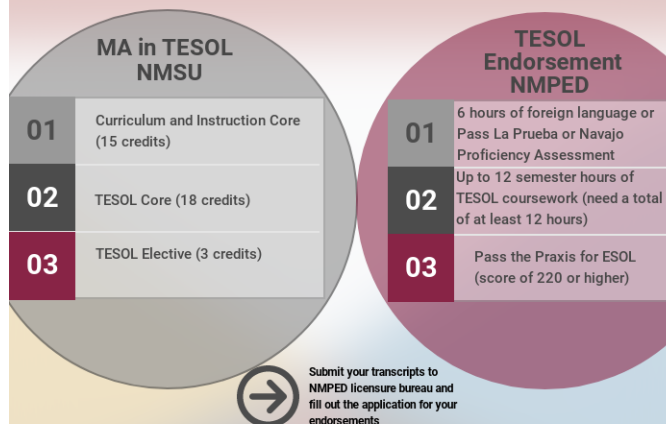
K-8 TESOL Endorsement Requirements (Pre-service Educators)
